As a civic association, we are involved in a wide variety of issues that affect our community directly -- parks, transportation, our environment, crime in the neighborhood, power reliability -- you name it! Every other month, with the exception of the summer months, the NFCCA newsletter is delivered to your doorstep. Meetings are usually held on the second Wednesday of the month at our local, elementary school, Forest Knolls located at 10830 Eastwood Avenue.



FOREST KNOLLS POOL

Built in 1963 and nestled against the towering trees of Northwest Branch Park, Forest Knolls Pool is a community gathering place where neighbors enjoy the sparkling water and the surrounding woods. It is located at 11105 Foxglove Lane. Memberships can be transferred when homes are sold so you might want to look into that. Located at 211 Southwood Avenue, the North Four Corners Local Park is our local neighborhood park. It has a couple of tennis courts, basketball, a large open field for soccer, baseball, or just plain fun, a large meadow in the back, and a recreational center that can be rented out. The playground is best suited for younger children.

A block behind us is the Northwest Branch. Look it up! It is fantastic! If you take the trail towards Colesville Road, cross the main street, and pick it up again behind the county building next to the

BP, it leads all the way to the Anacostia with beautiful boulders and a variety of landscapes. If you head in the opposite direction, it will eventually get you to Wheaton Regional Park another fabulous

park located next to Brookside Gardens. The best way to get there is to continue down Glenwild Road (heading in the opposite direction of the cul-de-sac), cross Margate, until you read Lockridge. The forest entrance is on your right.
